





Just then, a miracle happened! The storm stopped and the ocean became calm.

When Makhan Shah arrived at Bakala to find the True Guru, he saw there were many men with followers claiming to be the Guru.




A villager told him there were many pretenders who claimed to be the True Guru. The people didn't know who the True Guru was. Makhan Shah came up with a plan.



Makhan Shah became very excited. "Here is your other gold. I was just trying to find out who the True Guru was. "You saved me Guru Ji, I am at your service."


